## Subject: Post Inspection Letters from Vanuatu Maritime Services.

- 1. The Vanuatu Maritime Services has issued fleet/safety letter 070117.GEN.
- 2. Salient points of the letter are as follows:
  - 1. The Administration will issue corrective action letter to vessel post inspection conducted either by Flag State inspector, Recognized Organization or Port State Control.
  - 2. These letters contains acknowledgement of deficiencies known to the Administration and corrective action with rectification timeline.
  - 3. The intent of letter is to help owners and managers to prevent Port State Control (PSC) detentions.
  - 4. Owners and managers are reminded to send PSC inspection reports (Form A and Form B) to <u>email@vanuatuships.com</u> and inform administration when a vessel is entering US ports, Tokyo MOU or Paris MOU ports.
- 3. Ship owners/ operators and masters are advised to be guided by above.
