## <u>Subject: Liberia Marine Advisory reg. Concentrated Inspection Campaign on Safety of Navigation</u>

- Paris Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) jointly with the Tokyo MoU; will be conducting a concentrated inspection campaign (CIC) from 01<sup>st</sup> September 2017 to 30<sup>th</sup> November 2017 with focus on navigation safety, including Electronic Chart Display Information Systems (ECDIS) and provided a questionnaire which will be used by Port State Control Officer.
- Liberia Maritime Authority has issued a marine advisory 07/2017 providing a pre-checklist developed by administration and guidance for the above CIC.
- Ship owners / operators and masters are advised to be guided by the attached Liberian marine advisory to determine compliance and/or preparing the vessels for CIC requirements.
