## To whomsoever it may concern

## Subject: Liberia- Facilitating Compliance without PSC Attendance at Australian ports.

- 1. The Liberia Maritime Authority has issued marine advisory: 06/2018 dated 31 July 2018 (Copy attached) stating that administration is developing a program jointly with AMSA (Australian Maritime Safety Authority) intended to facilitate compliance verifications of Liberian flagged vessels calling at Australian ports without AMSA attendance.
- 2. AMSA has agreed to let the administration take the lead on any vessel inspection provided the Master, owner or operator:
  - a) Notifies the administration in advance of the vessel's arrival
  - b) Includes a report of any safety concerns in form AMSA355
  - c) Confirms Liberian inspector attendance
- 3. The Administration can then assist with arranging the flag inspection, at a reduced cost to owners and operators if outside the normal ASI window, and working with the operator to notify AMSA of the actions and plan for repair (if necessary).
- 4. Ship owners/ operators and masters of Liberia flagged vessels are advised to be guided by above.
