

# **Technical Circular**

#### To Whomsoever it may concern

### Subject: Hostile Incident in the Bab El Mandeb Strait.

- Republic of Marshall Islands has issued Ship Security Advisory No. 12-16 (copy attached) advising vessels in the region of the Red Sea, Bab el Mandeb Strait and the Gulf of Aden to operate under a heightened state of alert as increasing tensions in the region escalate the potential for direct or collateral damage to vessels transiting the region.
- These threats may come from a variety of different sources such as missiles, projectiles, or waterborne improvised explosive devices.
- Vessel operators are advised to remain cautious when transiting the Bab el Mandeb Strait and consider the continued application of BMP4 ship protection measures until well out of the strait.
- Also vessels in the region are advised to report any hostile activities immediately to United Kingdom Marine Trade Operations (UKMTO) and Maritime Security Centre Horn of America (MSCHOA), and also contact coalition naval forces on VHF/ Email-catleader@me.navy.mil, or phone: +973 1785 3879.
- Ship owners/ operators and masters are advised to be guided by above.
